Below are some important reminders to help you prepare for your August 12 graduation:

RUN A NEW DEGREE AUDIT: Be sure that all degree requirements have been met for graduation with your spring courses. If you have any red Xs on your audit you should contact your CoJMC academic advisor right away! Your advisor will be able to assist you with clearing completed requirements or discuss concerns. Remember that you must refresh your audit each time you run it so it's always the latest update. Instructions for doing that can be found here.

CHECK TRANSFER CREDIT: If you have taken, or are currently taking, a class at another school and want to transfer it to UNL, send your transcripts to UNL Admissions as soon as possible. You cannot graduate until all final grades have been submitted. You can send them electronically to admissions@unl.edu.

REVIEW GRADUATION INFO IN THE LINK BELOW: TOMORROW, July 7, graduating students will receive a notification at their @huskers.unl.edu email account from the Office of the University Registrar requesting them to complete the Commencement and Diploma Form in MyRED. More info about this is in the link below. Everything related to your August 12th commencement is in the link, including ordering your cap and gown so read the important info in the following link.

1. Senior Exit Survey
